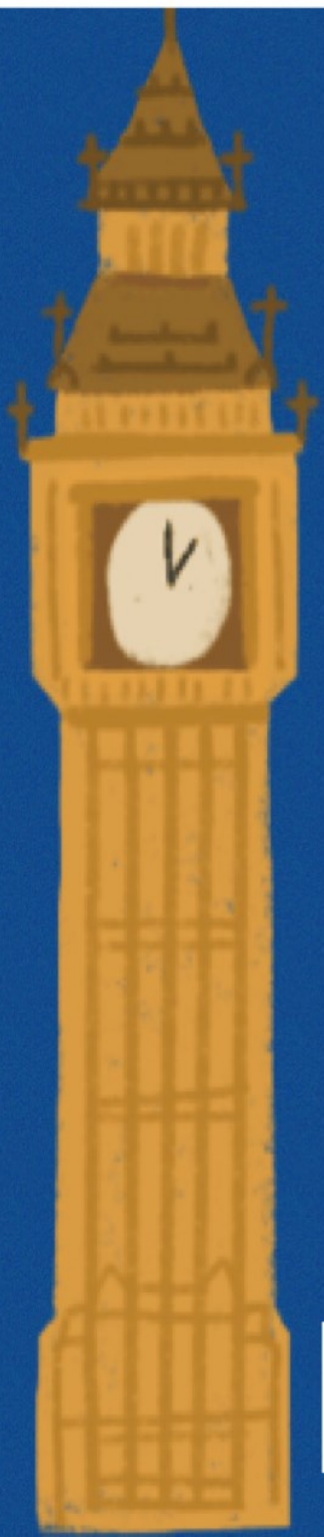

HOW TO USE IT ?

- PRACTICAL, THIS PACKAGING TAKES THE FORM OF FOOD (BISCUITS, FRUITS, PIECES OF CAKE...) OR CONTAINERS.
- JUST HEAT IT SLIGHTLY IN YOUR HANDS TO SHAPE IT.
- WASH WITH COLD WATER, WITH A LITTLE SOAP IF NECESSARY.
